

Hunter's Star Hidden Treasures Supply List Project Size 58" x 72"

Over 35 possible designs all starting with the same basic 8 Dark and 8 Light Fat Quarters plus borders. We will be using the Petite Rapid Fire Hunter's Star Tool. The design choice is up to you.



## Supply List:

- Hunter's Star Hidden Treasures book
- Studio 180 Design, Petite Rapid Fire Hunter's Star ruler
- sewing machine in good working order
- 6(1/2)" x 24(1/2)" ruler or your regular cutting ruler
- rotary cutter and mat
- Sewing supplies you like to use: 1/4" foot, sewing machine needles, thread for piecing, seam ripper, glass head pins, scissors, etc.

Best Press Invisi-Grip for back of your ruler Strip Stick

## Fabric and Pre-Class Cutting Instructions:

Fabric	Yardage	First Cut	Second Cut
Dark	8 Fat Quarters <u>or</u>	3 7" squares each FQ 2 1 3/4" strips each FQ 2 2 1/4" strips each FQ	cut in half once diagonally we will cut trapezoids in class
	2 Yards	<ul><li>24 7" squares</li><li>8 1 3/4" strips WOF</li><li>8 2 1/4" strips WOF</li></ul>	cut in half once diagonally we will cut trapezoids in class
Light	8 Fat Quarters <u>or</u>	3 7" squares ea. FQ 2 1 3/4" strips ea. FQ 2 2 1/4" strips ea. FQ	cut in half once diagonally we will cut trapezoids in class
	2 Yards	24 7" squares 8 1 3/4" strips WOF 8 2 1/4" strips WOF	cut in half once diagonally we will cut trapezoids in class
Inner Border	1/2 Yard if pieced 1 5/8 Yards with no piecing		
Outer Border and Binding	1 3/4 Yards
