Black	3/4 Yard	2 5" strips X WOF 3 1 3/4" strips x WOF	16 5" squares
Star Points 8 different fabrics	1/8 Yard each	8 2 1/4" strips x WOF* (one strip each color)	
Inner Border	1/4 Yard		
Outer Border	1/2 Yard if cut WOF 1 1/4 Yards if cut lengthwise		
Border Cornerstones	1/8 Yard		

* Jelly Roll strips are an option. It is not a problem that they are cut a little larger than needed.

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
