

Sea Glass

Project Size: 54 1/2" x 63"

I love the beach, and this quilt arranges diamond shapes in a unique way that reminds me of the glass shards found on the shore. The pattern uses the Diamond Rects tool to make precise diamond shapes, and I love the squares on point for the great effect in the border.

Fabric Requirements:

| Light Background: | 1 yard |
| Dark Background: | 1 3/8 yards |
| Coordinating Medium Scraps: | 1 1/4 yards mixed scraps |
| Backing: | 4 yards |



Instructions Pre-Class Cutting

| Quilt Section | Pieces | Fabric | Cut |
|-------------------------|------------------|---------------------|----------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| Spinning Diamond Blocks | Diamonds | Medium Value Scraps | 7- 2 1/2" wide strips or the equivalent if using scraps* |
| | Side Triangles | Light Background | 7 - 3" strips* |
| | Center Square | Medium Value Scraps | 20 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" |
| Framed Blocks | Center Square | Medium Value Scraps | 12 Squares 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" |
| | Framing Strips | Black | 24 rectangles 2" x 3 1/2" |
| | | Black | 24 rectangles 2" x 6 1/2" |
| Pieced Border | Squares | Medium Value Scraps | 40 squares 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" |
| | Triangles | Black | 22 squares 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" sub cut on <u>BOTH</u> diagonals |
| Setting Triangles | Side Triangles | Black | 4 squares 10 1/2" sub cut on <u>BOTH</u> diagonals (slightly oversized) |
| | Corner Triangles | Black | 2 squares 6" sub cut on <u>ONE</u> diagonal (slightly oversized) |

Class Supplies

- Studio 180 Design Sea Glass Pattern
- Studio 180 Design Diamond Rects Tool
- Invisi-Grip recommended for back of tools
- 6 x 24 Ruler
- Cutting Mat & Rotary Cutter (with new blade)
- Fabric pre-cut for class - see cutting instructions
- Sewing machine in good working order
- 1/4" foot
- Thread and bobbins
- Sizing or Best Press (optional but recommended)
- General sewing kit - scissors, pins, seam ripper, machine needles, etc.
