- Studio 180 Signs of Autumn Pattern
- Sewing supplies you like to use including: seam ripper, glass head pins, and scissors.

Light Background	3/8 Yard	Flying Geese Quickets Corner Beam Leaf Background	32 2 1/2" squares 9 2 1/2' squares 1 4" x 12" strip 3 3 1/2" squares 6 2" x 3 1/2" rectangles
Dark Frame	1/4 yard	Inner Border	You can cut this later
Border and Binding	5/8 yard total	Outer Border Binding	You can cut this later
