- 1/4" presser foot
- Rotary cutter and mat
- Ruler 6 (1/2)" x 24 (1/2)"
- Studio 180 Rulers: Wing Clipper I, Corner Beam, Quilter’s Magic Wand
- Studio 180 Signs of Autumn Pattern
- Sewing supplies you like to use including: seam ripper, glass head pins, and scissors.
