



Masquerade Appliqué Wall Hanging or Table Runner Supply List

Project Sizes: 27 1/2" x 48" or 18 1/2" x 48 1/2"



A great fall wall hanging or a table runner for any time of year. Using Studio 180 Design's Rapid Fire Hunter's Star Petite Ruler make eight pointed stars that appear to be floating. We will cover the appliqué in class one, but if you wish to make the table runner join us for class two.

Sewing Supplies:

- Thread for piecing
 - Size 80 Universal Needles
 - Sewing machine in good working order
 - 1/4" foot
 - Rotary cutter and mat
 - Ruler 6 (1/2)" x 24 (1/2)"
 - Studio 180 Design Petite Rapid Fire Hunter's Star tool
 - Studio 189 Masquerade Pattern
 - Sewing supplies you like to use including: seam ripper, pins, scissors, etc.
 - Steam a Seam or other fusible appliqué product*
 - 40 Weight cotton thread for blanket stitch in colors that match your fabrics*
- * only for appliqué wall hanging

Invisigrip for back of ruler

Fabric Requirements and Pre-Class Cutting Instructions:

Fabric	Appliqué	Table Runner	First Cut	Second Cut
Background (Black)	1 1/8 yd	3/4 yd	2 5" strips WOF 3 1 3/4" strips x WOF 10" x 20" rectangle for appliqué background*	16 5" squares done in class
Star Points 8 different fabrics	1/8 yd each	1/8 yd each	8 2 1/4" strips x WOF	
Inner Border	1/4 yd	1/4 yd		
Outer Border	1/2 yd if cut WOF 1 1/4 yd if cut lengthwise	1/2 yd if cut WOF 1 1/4 yd if cut lengthwise		
Border Cornerstones	1/8 yd	1/8 yd		

Jelly Roll strips are an option for star points. It is not a problem that they are cut a little larger than needed.

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
