

Filigree Supply List

Lap 54" x 70", Twin 70" x 86", Queen 86" x 102"

A unique variation on a traditional Snail's Trail block. Instead of a four patch in the center, there are two pointy triangles giving you interlocking twists - a unique effect reminding us of filigree scrollwork. With the addition of the Corner Beam units between the Snail's trail blocks you have even more spikey interest!

Scrappy Pinks(Blues) (dark/medium)	2 yards	3 1/4 yards	4 3/4 yards
Inner Border	5/8 yard	3/4 yard	7/8 yard
Outer Border/Binding	2 yards	3 yards	3 1/2 yards
Backing	4 yards	6 yards	9 yards

Supplies:

Studio 180 Design pattern Filigree Corner Beam Tool Large Square Squared Tool 6 x 24 (approximate) Ruler Rotary Cutter

Mat

Sewing Machine in good working order

Sewing supplies you like to use - 1/4" foot, thread, bobbins, glass head pins, seam ripper, scissors, sewing machine needles, etc.

Precutting Instructions:

Cut all your Scrappy Whites and your Scrappy Pink (Dark/medium) Fabrics into squares per instructions except the Corner Beam Side Triangles (cut 5" strips only) and the Snail's Trail Center (cut 2" strips only).

Be sure to label your pieces using paper plates or plastic bags to keep them organized.
